



CURRICULUM INFORMATION

At Good Samaritan Academy our teachers use the WEE Learn curriculum, the Kindness Curriculum and the All About Preschoolers Curriculum as a guide in selecting activities that provide a balanced program of early childhood education.

A child's growth and development is viewed as an ongoing process and our teachers create lesson plans each week that cover the spiritual, physical, emotional and social development of the children in their care.

Teachers incorporate unit topics into every area of the day:

- Group time activities
- Outdoor time activities
- Snack time activities
- Art Center
- Block Center
- Book and Listening Centers
- Circle Time
- Homeliving Centers
- Music/Devotion
- Puzzles and Manipulatives

Children are individuals who learn at their own pace. This learning is best supported when the child is an active participant and is allowed to investigate while being provided opportunities to engage in hands-on work.

Our teachers provide children with learning environments that allow them to explore, discover, create, and interact with others and the environment. Opportunities for communication, developing self-esteem and self-control are also a priority.
